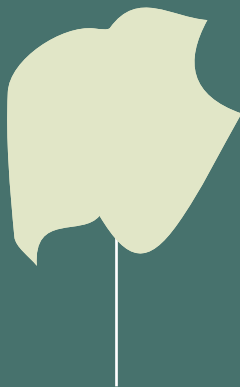

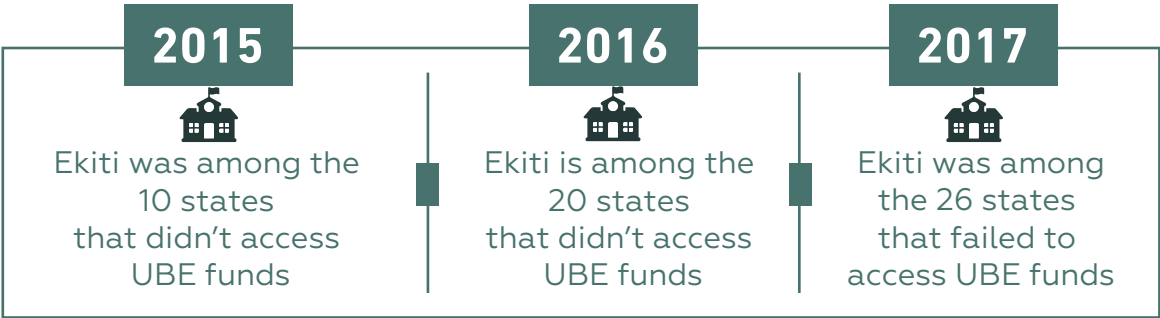

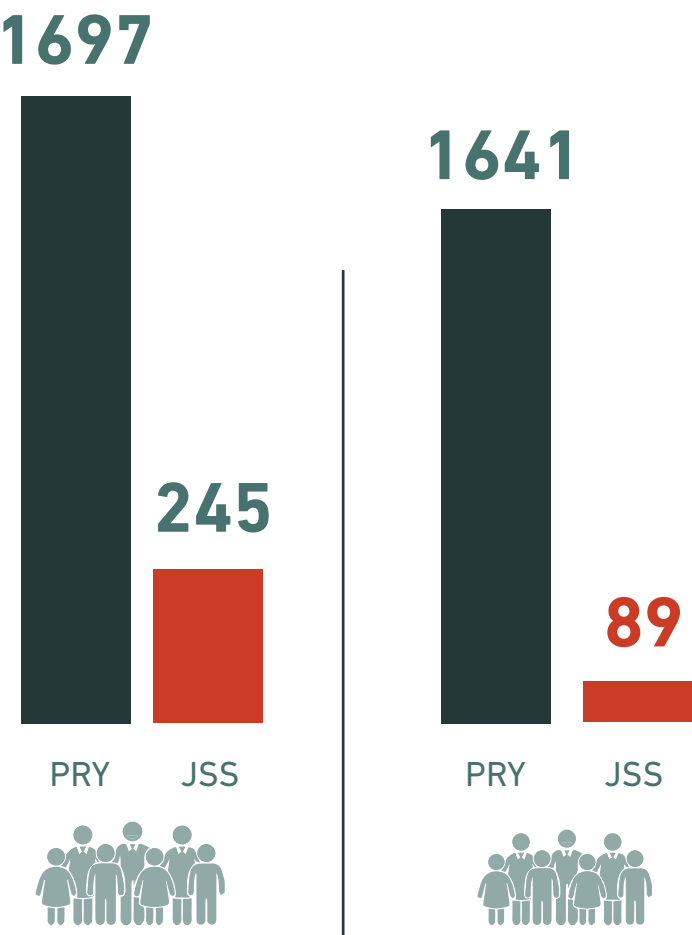

NUMBER OF TEACHERS



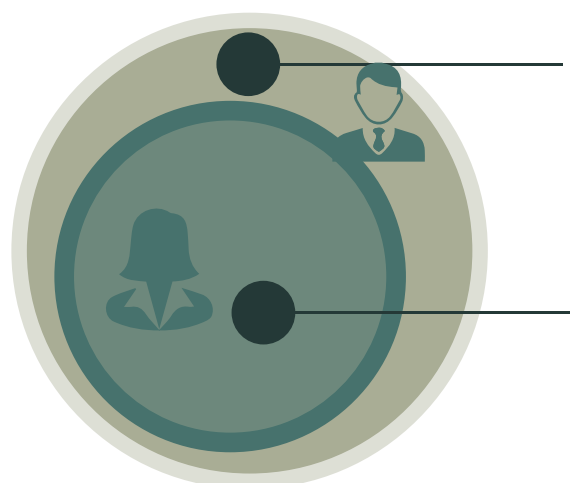

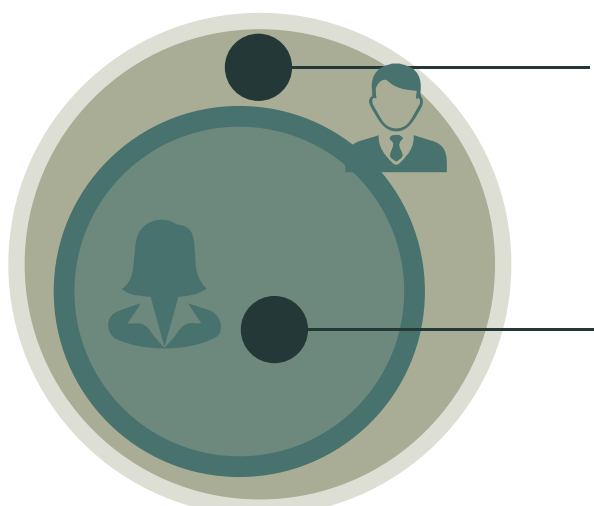

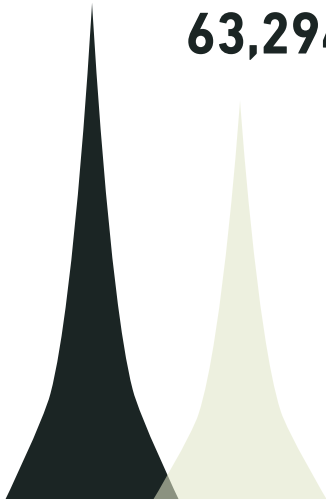


PUPIL ENROLMENT

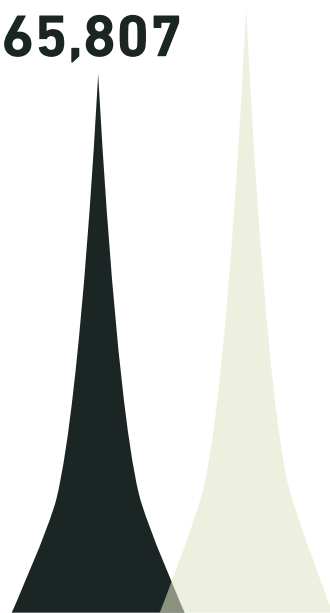
